	<p>Day 1 Windhoek - Bed & Breakfast OR Self-catering</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upon arrival at Windhoek's International Hosea Kutako Airport, you get transferred to the vehicle rental office in town• Take over your rental vehicle and start your Namibia self-drive safari with a drive to your accommodation situated in Windhoek.• <u>Optional Activities</u>: Sightseeing, shopping, relaxing
	<p>Day 2 Okahandja – Bed & Breakfast</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Today you meet the first culture of Namibia the Herero people• On the last weekend before 26 August the Herero celebrate the arrival of a steam train in Okahandja carrying the coffin of one of their chief, Chief Samuel Maharero. Samuel Maharero had fled the country after the massacre at the Waterberg and lived in exile until his death. He was then brought back to Namibia to be buried.• Every year the Herero dress up, the men in a military style uniform and the women in colourful uniform like dresses, to visit their chief's graves and pay homage. (Alternative: Zeruaa day in Omaruru)
	<p>Day 3 + 4 Omaruru – Selfcatering OR Camping</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continuing further north you reach the Erongo Mountains, close to the town of Omaruru.• Here you settle for two nights and visit the Living Museum of the San on one morning taking your time to let 4 families introduce you to the traditional way of living of the bushmen.
	<p>Day 5 + 6 Etosha – Bed & Breakfast OR Camping</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Having seen two different cultures already you surely need a break and experience something different.• How about some game viewing in Etosha National Park• Trace lion, elephant, rhino as well as plenty of plane game during your two night stay.

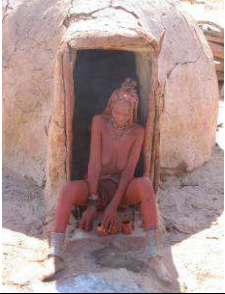

Day 7 Himba –Bed & breakfast

- After two days of game viewing it is time for some more cultural meeting
- The next tribe you will be introduced to are the Himba nomads.
- The Himba still live according to the rules of their ancestors, living from cattle and a little craftsmanship



Day 8 + 9 Twyfelfontein – Bed & Breakfast OR Camping

- Leaving the southern borders of the Etosha National Park your road takes you to Namibia's only world heritage, the rock engravings of Twyfelfontein.
- While here you should definitely also pay an optional visit to the Petrified Forest, the Organ Pipes as well as the Burnt Mountain.
- Most important though on your cultural trip is a visit to the Living Museum of the Damara, based close to Twyfelfontein



Day 10 - 12 Swakopmund – Bed & Breakfast OR Selfcatering

- After all these days of cultural meetings it is now time to relax a little before your short excursion to Namibia comes to an end
- Travelling south you pass the Brandberg with the famous White Lady bushman painting (Optional extension)
- Reaching the coast you can pay a visit to the biggest Cape Fur Seal colony along the Southern African Coast at Cape Cross
- Then you depart to Swakopmund, Namibia's most favourite holiday town
- Optional activities: Dolphin cruise, Living Desert Adventures, Sand boarding, Sky diving, quad biking, horse riding



Day 13 Windhoek/Departure

- Drive back to Windhoek on good tar roads, via Usakos, Karibib and Okahandja you reach the International airport in the later afternoon, well in time for your outbound flight (Optional extension down south to Sossusvlei, Fish River Canyon, Kalahari Desert.
